

All in all this is a very well written book and is a staple for anyone wanting to learn about animal breeding and the pros of making a few small changes to your breeding program. This book is also quite lighter than you'd expect a book of its size to be so I would not recommend it as a paper-weight.

Animal breeding tends to be full of algebra and maths, which hamper understanding. This is not the case here and the author goes to intuition and gives lots of practical examples. Yet he has lots of rigor. Very good.

This book was recommended to me by a college professor who teaches horse breeding genetics. She said that although the book is not specifically about horses, she finds the information in it to be more correct than many texts that are.
