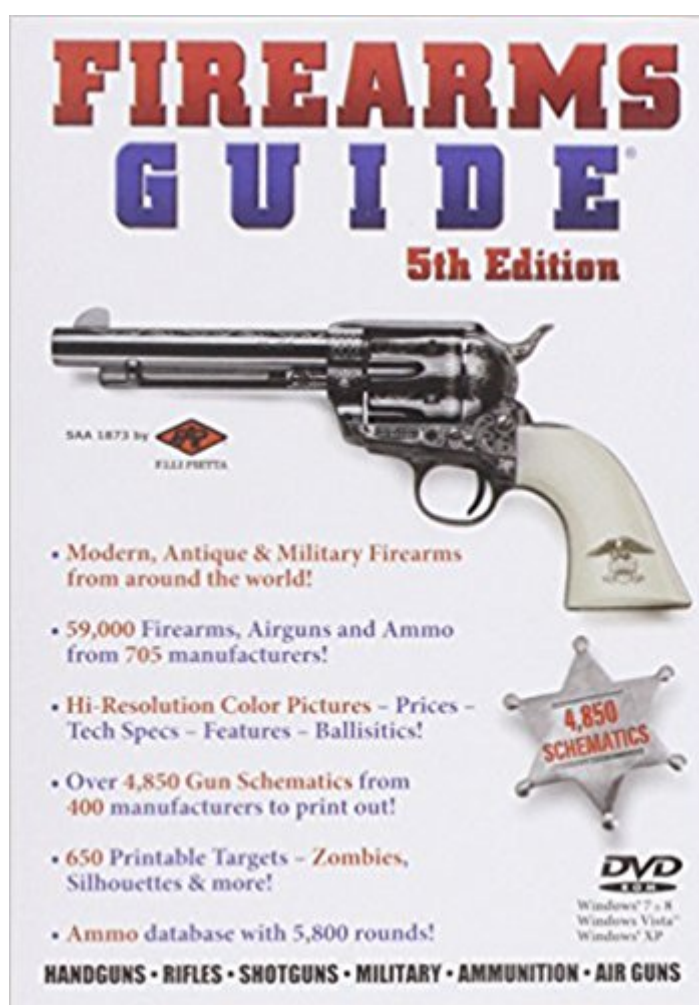

This review is based on a superficial comparison of the 3rd edition from 12012 and the 5th edition from 2014.While I am into guns on an interest level, and find the whole database entertaining and

useful, I personally only shoot firearms on occasion. I'm an air rifle guy, and was flabbergasted just to see such an extensive database of air rifles being part of the database. It had serious shortcomings, though; wrinkles which I counted on being ironed out two editions and considerable time later. Sadly, this was not to be the case. While much content has been added, the flaws of previous editions have not been properly addressed. First, there's a number of double, triple and quadruple entries on the same gun, which is not necessarily a bad thing in itself. Sometimes there will be different versions of the same model, with one being so different from the other that it deserves a separate entry. However, I've come across several instances in which no such excuse can be made. If a certain model comes with several different barrel lengths, with everything else being identical, does that really warrant several entries on the otherwise exact same gun? - Not in my opinion. And not in the author's opinion either, it seems: Many guns are indeed listed with only one entry per model, while information on what lengths, etc. are available is found on that gun's info page. That seems to me like the proper way to do this. While I can understand that keeping track of tens of thousands of entries is not an easy task, I would expect this issue to come up and be dealt with during quality control. Quality control does seem to be the issue here. I'm quite certain that if the author sent out test copies to a handful of handgunmen, riflemen, airgun-boys (like me) and so on before finalizing the project and going for release, this would be a much better product. An able airgun-fellow, for instance, would immediately notice a glaring hole in the list of manufacturers. How come one of the industry's best and most trusted manufacturers (Weihrauch, Germany) is not even listed? Oh, that's right; it's marketed in many countries, USA included, as Beeman Precision Airguns, and that brand name is listed. I can forgive this inaccuracy in the listings, but how come their only PCP (pre-charged pneumatics) rifle, which has been out since '97 (and has been considered one of the absolute best hunting air rifles on the market since then), was not listed in the 3rd edition (bad enough) or the current edition (a travesty)? This might seem like nitpicking to the airgun outsider, but omitting Weihrauch HW100 (with sporter or thumbhole stock from different materials, several different lengths and with or without shrouded barrel; they could have made a dozen entries on this air rifle alone) from the air rifle section is kind of like omitting H&K MP5 from the submachine gun section. I guess I am biased, as the aforementioned Weihrauch HW100 is one I own and use and love. There are many good things about this guide, the sheer size of it being one; there's SO MUCH information here. Nice HD pictures of most (or many) guns is another. But all in all, the guide falls short of what it could be with additional quality control. There are just way too many instances of sloppy, unnecessary errors for me to give it anything more than three stars (I would give it 3.5 if possible). I was hoping for - even counting on - this to be a considerable upgrade

from the 3rd edition on the quality side, but was disappointed. Adding new information is a good thing, but perhaps optimizing what you already have should be a priority? Note: This review is based on fooling around with the 5th edition for less than an hour. I might come back and edit this if something of substance jumps out and causes me to change my overall opinion.

I bought this over a year ago, hoping to have a great resource...Horrible software, customer service is worse. I am VERY disappointed. Very frustrating to "try" to use. 5th edition and they can't make the menus work? When in Schematics, ammo, targets, or FFL, the top menu doesn't work. I have to close the program and start again. Scroll bars don't scroll visually so you have to "guess" when to stop scrolling, mouse wheel in the lists is ?? Mouse wheel will not scroll the schematics. There is no way to scale the size of the schematics, you are stuck with the crappy scrolling on pictures that are WAY too big. Schematics are available on the internet for free usually...The guns currently on my bench aren't in the schematics - Marlin 700, Browning Buckmark, Stevens 1915, Armas Erbi, S&W 642, yes, i know the 642 is similar to others. Information like trigger pull, length of pull and other types of information is missing from a LOT of guns. Incorrect picture for Beretta 92 FS INOX, the picture shown is a Vertec, The Vertec isn't listed, The Brigadier is also not listed. 2 Operation is clunky and slow. I had high hopes for this but it feels rushed, and like it was put together by a novice programmer. This disc is NOT worth \$40, \$10 maybe. I tried every available venue to TRY to get some help from these people, Not one response, Until (a year later) I got an email asking me to pay MORE money to use their online service?? Really?? I responded to THAT email with my issues and asked for a refund. I got the standard canned response that "once you open a DVD you can't get a refund, go to Best Buy if you don't believe us." DO NOT BUY.

We started out with edition 3, then 4 and recently received the latest 5th edition. As a Federal Firearms dealer this reference is exceptional in layout, content and ease of use. We use it on a daily basis. It is so much quicker than the various printed books. We highly recommend anyone in the business of firearms or just a collector/ user obtain a copy; you will find this an invaluable and very useful tool. On another note, because we have been so pleased with this DVD version for 3 editions we obtained a copy of their AR RIFLES DVD, another winner!
