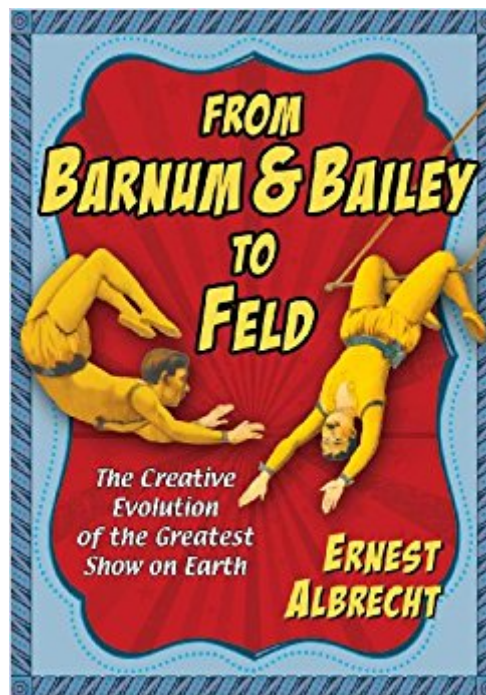

Great book, great service

This book is good and important. Among the thousands of books written about circus, this is the rare one that comprehensively addresses the overlap of creativity, business, and the original foundation of circus – the animal-human partnership, over the long history of the Greatest Show on Earth. Starting in the second century of American circus, that show's history runs from Barnum in his late-career venture in circus in 1871 (when he leapt to take credit for partners' ideas and older practices), to his crucial partner Bailey, and through the Ringling family, to the current producers, the Feld family. Avoiding traditional sentimentality about circus, the book offers the stuff of good history: a wealth of specific evidence, crafted in an interesting narrative. That evidence includes both extensive research and decades of the author's personal experience reviewing circuses, an invaluable combination.

This is a circus junkie's dream. The book is an excellently researched and written history of the evolution of the Barnum and Bailey Circus to its current manifestation run by Kenneth Feld's daughters. I learned so much about the celebrities and spectacles staged over the years. There are many wonderful visual aids to enhance your enjoyment including one in which well over thirty elephants are posed in tutus each one with its front legs on the back of the one in front. I never fully realized how extravagant it all was. Even today there is so much care and effort put into the production. I wish it was coming to town so I could go.

Well written and insightful. The author examines what it takes to capture the public imagination when your stage is a massive big top or a multi-thousand seat arena. Carefully researched and thoroughly documented, the book will be welcomed by scholars and enjoyed by circus enthusiasts of all stripes. Highly recommended.
