

Other notable novels include *THE RIB OF THE GREEN UMBRELLA*(1960), *THE YOUNG ALFRED THE GREAT*(1962), and *MEMOIRS OF A SPACE WOMAN*(1962). A resident of London and of Carradale, Scotland, she died in 1999.
