

Homeschoolers and teachers: buy this! This book provides beautiful photographs of art and architecture in the ancient world. But more importantly, it develops the context of interconnectedness among these cultures, showing the borrowing between cultures and the development through time. It's sensational. Humans are creative, and they are cooperative, and they are mimics. Human see, human do. This book does a tremendous job at continuity and cooperation among trading partners and competing war bands. What I especially like are the tie-ins: Carthage gets a mention, and the book ties it in to the Aeneid. Prehistoric Israel ties in to modern Israel. It's awesome.

This book is the first of four books in Rosen Publishing's Witness To History series. This one covers history from the evolution of man through to the end of the ancient

world. Overall, I found this book to be a bit of a mixed bag. The pages are jam-packed with paragraphs and sidebars and pictures, giving them a very busy, almost overwhelming look. The book attempts to cover the early history of man, all around the world, which means that there are chapters on Persia, India and China, and even one on Africa, though none on the Americas. Indeed, this book's biggest problem is that it does try to cover too much in too small of a space. Some subjects are covered very well, while others are not. The book looks like a school-book, perhaps as part of a curriculum, and it may be that it is very good as that. As a reading book, it is rather busy and crowded, making for a not very pleasant reading experience. I give it a guarded recommendation.
