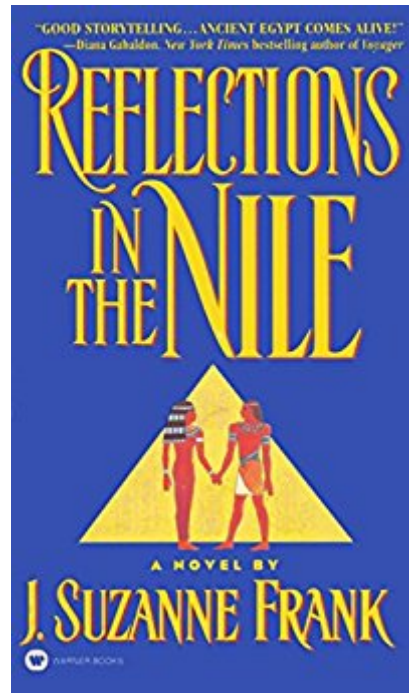

The story was an interesting concept, but the characters seemed a little stiff and uninspiring. Connecting the storyline with Bible stories gave the story more interest, but even so the novel lagged for me from the middle through the last quarter of the book. The most frustrating thing for me was the frequent typos, misspelled words and wrongly placed punctuation in my Kindle version. The errors seemed to get even more frequent toward the end of the book. This causes me to be pulled right out of the story, diminishes my reading pleasure, and is the main reason for my 3 stars.

Frank presents a fascinating view of ancient Egypt. The author weaves in biblical stories with action and adventure. It's more than a love story.

The story had the potential for a very interesting plot and Ms. Frank seems to have done her

homework on the historical aspects. However, it was poorly written in many places and full of mistakes, at least in the ebook version.

I have the printed version of this book, but I wanted it for my kindle. It has a few typos (th's are replaced with m's a lot) but otherwise a really great read!
