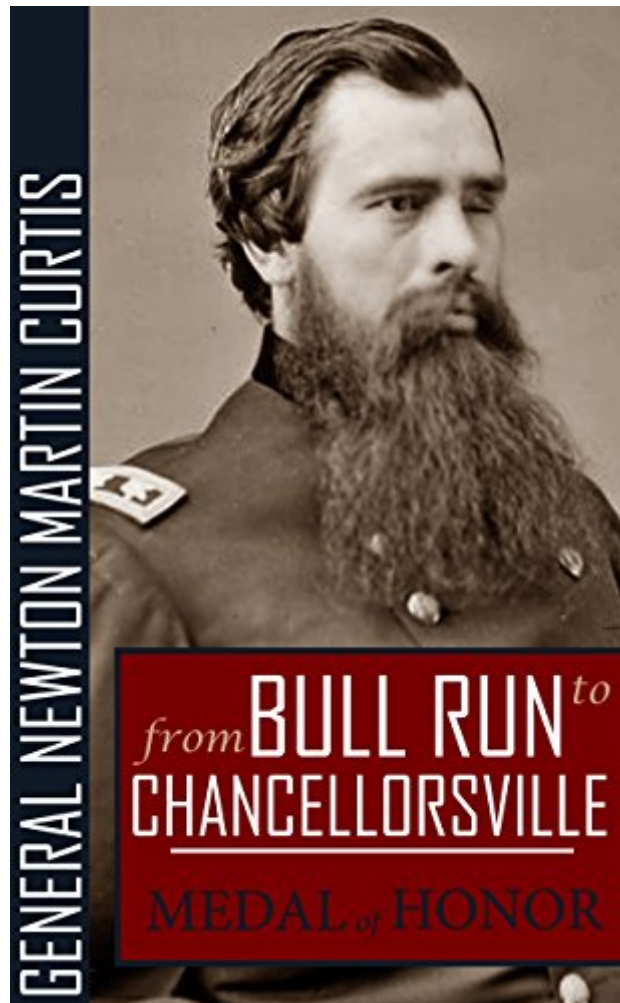




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From Bull Run To Chancellorsville: Medal Of Honor (Abridged)



Synopsis

When Medal of Honor recipient, Newton Martin Curtis, joined up to fight for the Union during the American Civil War, he had a presentiment that he would survive but that his eyesight would be somehow impaired. That is just what happened. General Curtis set out to write a history of the 16th New York Infantry Volunteers and he did accomplished that goal with skill. But his own experiences are what captivate you as a reader in this memoir. Known as the "hero of Fort Fisher," he threw a handful of shovels over to the Rebels shouting "Dig Johnnies! I'm coming for you!" Curtis made good on his promise and continued the attack, being wounded at the head of his brigade. He fought in the Peninsula Campaign, Bermuda Hundred, and the Siege of Petersburg. He has a fascinating section in the book on what it is like to be in combat: "The question most frequently put to a veteran is the one which is the most difficult to answer, 'How did you feel when going into battle and while under fire?'" His explanation is an analysis that seems a century ahead of its time. He also discusses the Civil War hospital system, something he became familiar due to his wounds. Every memoir of the American Civil War provides us with another view of the catastrophe that changed the country forever.
