

This book is great for teaching Cause and Effect or explaining chain reactions. You will laugh at all the crazy things that happen one after the other just because it all started raining.

Beautiful and vivid illustration create the growing excitement of cause and effect to sheer panic of an out of control situation. *The Rain Came Down* is a wonderful gem of a book where everyone is affected by the drenching rain.
