

My main complaint is a bit unusual, but you should be forewarned. This slim paperback volume is printed in what appears to be 9 point type, i.e. the letters are significantly smaller than in "normal" books, with less space between lines. It makes it uncomfortable to read.

This is an excellent reference for writers and readers of any ilk. The quotes are well chosen, and almost every president is well represented with the quote selection. The book is easy to use to the point of being faster than an electronic reference. It is no tome, but isn't meant to be, either.
