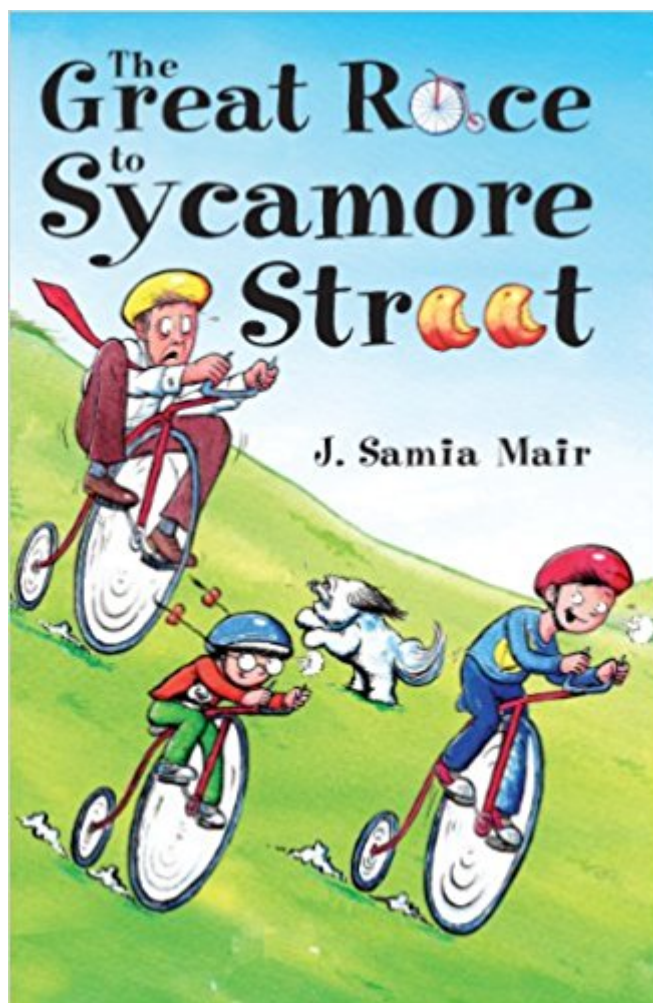

I really enjoyed reading this book with my daughter. We took turns reading pages, and we both really wanted to know what would happen to the peach tree which in an interesting way became a character in the story. This story is about a brother and sister who visit their Grandmother, a Turkish immigrant and widow, who lives in the fictional, small town of Fairfax, MD. It's an adventure tale revolving around a crisis that happens when a grouchy neighbor moves next door. The characters are Muslim and as such there are Islamic references throughout like common phrases that would be

said in a Muslim home such as Alhumdulilah (All praises to God), and inshallah (God willing). For me, these seemed natural and did not detract. Also, the Grandmother at times remind the kids of traditional stories or sayings as a way to guide their behavior or figure out how to deal with a problem. The author includes references at the back for those who might be unfamiliar with these stories. This is a great adventure story that would be a wonderful choice for any parent wanting to promote a love of reading and good morals and manners in their children. The book is suitable for 3-5 graders, although I will confess to enjoying it quite a bit myself.

My boys are enjoying this book immensely. They do not want me to put it down. The story is very exciting for them and they are also learning new words. Highly recommend it!

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
