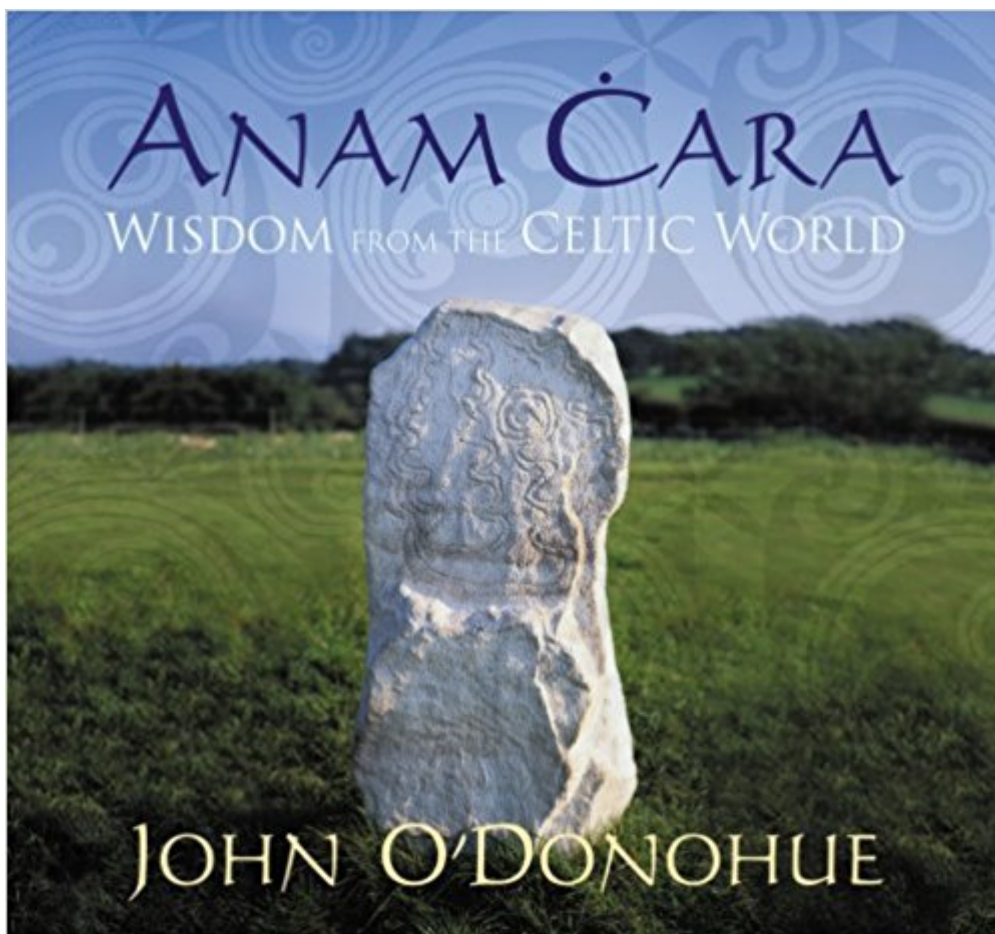

John O'Donohue (1956-2008) In early January 2008, the Sounds True family was deeply saddened by the loss of the Irish poet-philosopher John O'Donohue. John was a one-of-a-kind force of nature: a genius with words, a brilliant thinker, and a professional excavator of the soul. He will truly be missed. John O'Donohue was an Irish poet and Catholic scholar who was awarded a Ph.D. in philosophical theology from the University of Tübingen. He wrote several books including *Anam Cara*; *Air: Breath of God*; *Stone as the Tabernacle of Memory*; *Water: The Tears of the Earth*; and *Echoes of Memory*, a book of poems. John authored the Sounds True audio programs *Anam Cara*, *Beauty: The Invisible Embrace*, and *Wisdom from the Celtic World*. His final work was *To Bless the Space Between Us*, a collection of Celtic invocations and blessings.
