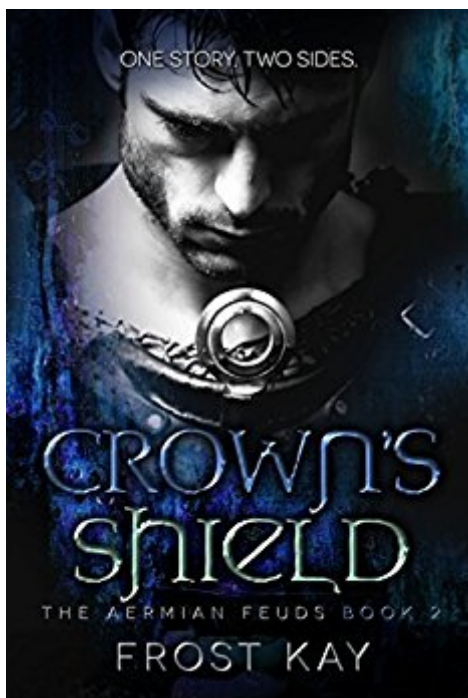


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Crown's Shield: The Aermian Feuds: Book Two

Frost Key's Crown Shield is a heart retrenching story about how the world as you see it isn't always black and white. Picking up from where Rebels Blade ended, we are trusted back into this enchanting world, like a gun shot. I was slack-jawed by

the first book, the cliff-hanger was movie worthy and Sage, she is by far one of my most favourite heroines of all time. This book has outshined its predecessor, and has set the stage for an epic explosive next installment that I can't wait to get my hands on. There is so much I want to say, to spill.. to spoil. But, as I do with most second books, I keep it to the structure. There are too many things that can spoil the first book from the second's review. And that my friends isn't something I want to do. This book picks up right where the previous one ended and continues to build momentum. The heart of this series continues to be Sage and how she is trying to heal Aermian. Sadly, Sage doesn't always receive the same consideration in return. It can tear your heart out at times. The characters that you loved in the first book, you will love more in this one. We learn more about Rafe and the rebellion in this book (for better or for worse). We also begin to understand that not all races in this world are what we'd classify as human. You start to see tantalizing glimpses of other countries and what might be happening there that may be addressed in future books. I love this book until it ended. It ends on a whopping cliffhanger. If you thought book 1 ending was a cliffhanger, then don't read this one until book 3 is out, because book 1 ending was gentle and this is anything but. Note: Some characters in this book have a prequel novella, Siren's Lure. You can read Siren's Lure first or after Crown's Shield. I think I'd recommend Siren's Lure first but I read Crown's Shield first and had no issues.

Crown's Shield picks up where Rebels Blade finishes. If you liked the first book you will love this second book, the plot has grown further, and it's becoming exciting and scary in parts. Frost Kay made me scream and shout ... I was reading then Bam cliffhanger and it ended. That doesn't mean I didn't absolutely love the book. It just means this cliffhanger was at a crucial part. I need

answers.....**patiently waits for book 3**, You will devour Crowns Shield and be hungry for more! Sage and Tehl start to get along more in this book, circumstances bring them more into each others lives, they find a way to make it work mutually. We are getting glimpses of the other lands in book two. Sirens Lure (prequel novella) also shares more on other lands, and back stories on a few characters in Crowns Shield.

The above headline is the first line of the book. It gave me chills! It can be difficult to navigate the good and the bad on Kindle Unlimited, so let me start by saying that I highly recommend this series for writing quality and the story itself. This series contains subtle but thorough world building and characterization. I was so glad to not have to wait long for Crowns Shield after reading Rebels Blade (book 1) because of the cliffhanger at the end. And it would seem that the author LOVES cliffhangers because there is one in this installment as well! Over all a perfectly executed sequel in a well loved series. The only area where I find the author's writing to be occasionally lacking is in the character dialogue. Sometimes I feel that many of the characters "sound" the same when they speak.

Crown's Shield is the second book in The Aermian Feuds Series and Frost Kay continues to amaze with her fantastic story telling! She builds even more depth into the main characters in this book as well as introducing a very intriguing ships captain that I loved every scene she appeared in. The plot continues to grow and at times keeps the reader off balance which I love. We see glimpses into two other kingdoms that leave the imagination racing with the possibilities of what we might find within them and their people! We also get to watch Sage work through her own personal demons but she is not alone with the adoration and support of her new found friends.
