

Learning times tables is often a chore for many children. They find it difficult to learn and some do not retain the information. Without a good foundation in maths, it is difficult for children to be able to fully and accurately learn other parts of mathematics. One of the many strengths in this book are the mnemonic rhymes they reinforce the cheerful graphics and colors and inevitably make learning fun. The material is useful and it is presented in a clear way which is easy to follow and precludes any confusion. This little book accomplishes a lot demystifying the complex world of multiplication for 7/8 year olds. It is especially helpful for children who have math anxiety, by circumventing their "mental block" - they can learn the tables without difficulties. They see it as fun and is a definite confidence booster. This brief summary does no justice to Ms. Monaghans book! Buy the book and see the results for yourself! I highly recommend it!
