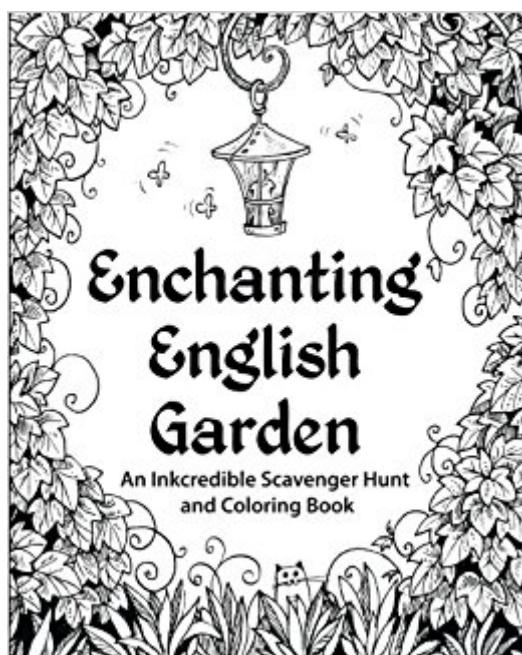


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Enchanting English Garden: An Inkcredible Scavenger Hunt And Coloring Book

This book is full of delightful, enchanting, fanciful, illustrations, and every single unique amazing picture will captivate you. But there is even more, the book is 1 inch thick with a total of 80 coloring pages and the back of each page is left blank. I was captivated as I looked through this charming book the first time. Every time I turned the page, the next picture surprised me and by the end of the book I was totally astonished. Imagine that somebody took the very best pictures out of 80 coloring books and published them in just one book. This book is like that. Every illustration is outstanding with the art style, amount of details, and complexity different and unique with each illustration. This would make a WOW gift for any school aged child and every adult that likes to color.

1. 80 unique and beautiful illustrations printed one per page (the back of each page is blank)

printed on medium weight, bright white paper, 2. The book is 8 inches x 10 1/8 inches. 3. The texture of the paper is extra nice for coloring. I tried colored pencils, both Prisma and Crayola, Gel pens, plus some markers and I was surprised at how easily, smoothly, and brilliantly the colors transferred to the page. This book is a joy to color. 4. Hidden throughout the book, in every illustration are 1 to 8 different scavenger hunt items, some in plain sight, and others hidden? When you think you have found all of the items in a particular illustration, turn the page to reveal a list for that illustration.

Cons: 1. The paper is only medium weight, so check your gel pens and markers they might bleed through, if they do use a scrap sheet of paper under the page you are coloring and don't remove it until the page is completely dry. OR remove the page from the book. 2. Because there are so many pages in the book it is difficult to get the book to lie flat for coloring, but the binding is very strong so with muscle it does flatten out, or leave one side tipped up.

I like these types of books for adults vs the Intricate pattern or Tangled type books because they don't repeat a pattern ad nauseum. It is a lovely book, but not near as detailed as the Joanna Badsford books "Enchanted Forest: An Inky Quest & Coloring Book" and "Secret Garden". In fact, one of the pictures looks very similar to another I've seen in a Dover Press book of a watercan full of flowers. So if you have as many books as I have you can get an idea of the detail in this one. Lots of white space that I wouldn't use anything but pencil or crayon on. The paper in this book is thick and not as porous as the other two I mentioned, and that is a good thing if you want to work with gels. I did try a few markers on the back pages and got bleed through. This is fine as the images are printed on one side and blank on the other, but if you work the pages IN the book I recommend placing something behind the piece you are working on as there is no guarantee the marker will bleed all the way to the next page.

I can't stop coloring, and I really need to stop and work on my dissertation. But this coloring book is addicting. What better way to ignore the horrid things about life than to work meticulously to color inside lines, pick perfect color combinations, and take 5-6 hours to finish just one sheet? No better way way. I also work with little kids between ages 4-10 and they too are in love. I highly recommend for anyone who has no time to waste but wants to waste a lot of it anyway.

Not bad but I wouldn't repurchase as there are better books. Pages are thin so watercolors, thinner,

or markers are out of the question here, unless you put some kind of backing on each page. I've attached a page of one of the undesirable pics just for testing out my FC Polys for review purposes. Background was done using Prisma Premiers blended out with Vaseline. It's a good thing that they don't print back to back because the Vaseline did bleed through but not onto the next page. Others said this book is a version of the secret garden but I beg to differ. It has many pics of its own and some designs could be similar but they are not. It has a variety of many diff things and brings a variety that secret garden does not. However, if they upgraded the pages, the book itself could be better! If you like to find hidden objects then this would be fun but I, personally, don't prefer it. On the back of each page, there is a list of the hidden objects at the bottom BUT some nimrod printed it backwards LOL so you'd have to look at it through a mirror to figure out what it says if you don't have the gift to read backwards.

Zen and beautiful. This is the best coloring book I have ever come across. The illustration are beyond par, and lead one into a place of peace and wonder. I used gel pens and loved the results. My only wish is that the paper was not so porous, for the inks bleed through if they are wetter. I suggest using a blank piece of paper under the page you are coloring and not letting too much ink soak through, and for the manufacturer- can you do something about this problem, that being said I still would pick this book for an avid colorist or myself..

This book is one of the worst I have bought. It is a series of repro prints from other artists. The sizing of the designs is extremely variable - some are shrunk down to a size that is too small to color and some are so big that they run off the page. The paper is very low quality. Colored pencils show up as very grainy. Pictures on are on one side of the page.

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
