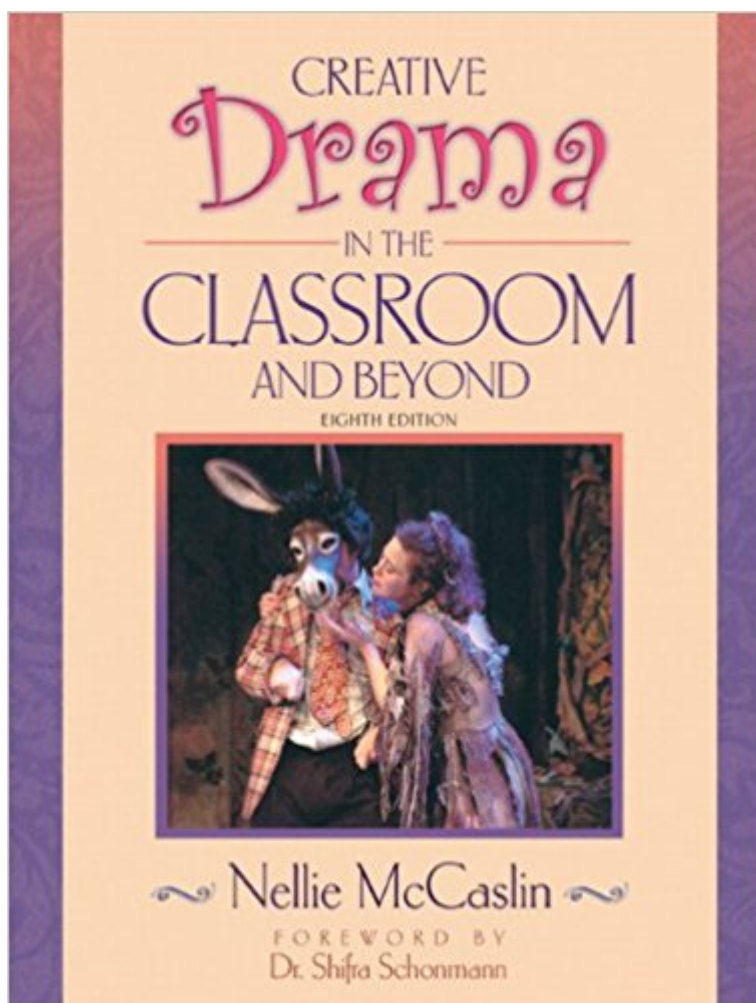

I dislike the product because it does not provide indepth insight into subject matter that's relevant for post secondary education. It attempts to talk about everything without saying anything; it lacks focus. The text seems to be highly saturated with suggested plays rather than more informative information regarding drama. Additionally, the price is ridiculous especially for a text with such paltry content.

I am teaching a course in Drama for Teachers, and bought this book because it was what the previous instructor had used. First, the retail price of this book is outrageous and totally unjustifiable, the publisher should be ashamed of themselves. When it arrived, I was completely underwhelmed at what was on offer intellectually and pedagogically in terms of this book. The lessons are not particularly creative, and judicious editing could cut this book in half, since only about half of the book has any notable content. It's not engaging for the adult students who would be taking such a course, and a lot of things here are very basic or outdated in their methodology. If you are an instructor, create a packet of readings from other sources- it will be better, more informative, and more interesting.
