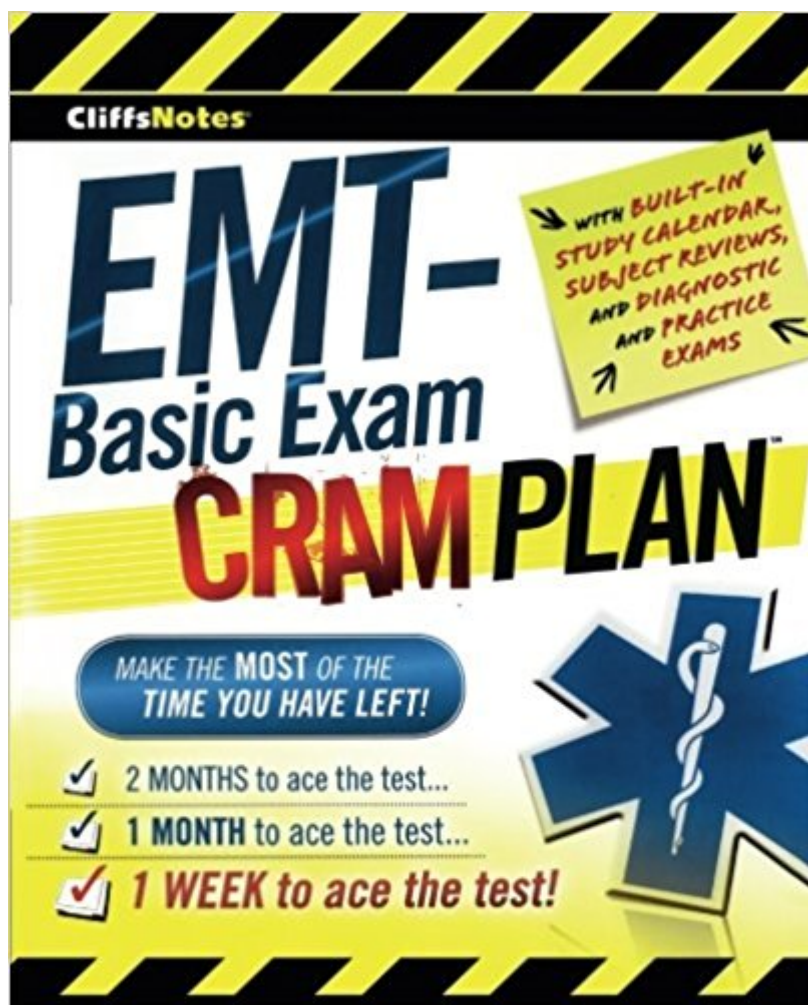

Like some other commenters have said, it's not the most thorough review content. There are several portions where the book alludes to something generally, even though it expects you to know it specifically from your own notes and training. For example, in my class we had to study all the specific indications and contraindications for pharmacology. The book doesn't specifically list it out for you, but asks questions about it. Another example is the specific maladies you may need to know for pregnancy (placenta previa, etc). The chapter goes into description of just two things or so, but that's about it. It's not like Barron's from highschool AP exams or entrance exams in college where they list all the definitions. It's more of a practical guide of what you need to know. That being said, the diagnostic exam is very good, and the practice questions are great and pretty close to the real thing. Their descriptions explaining the answers are also very good. I wasn't that impressed with the book, but I'm giving 3 stars because it worked well enough for me and I passed my exam just fine. I did refer though to some worksheets from my actual EMT B class which is a little annoying. The diagnostic exam was comprehensive and gave me a good idea of what to expect. It's also probably the most affordable compared to some of the other options out there.

I purchased the book shortly after graduating EMT class to help study for the exam. The book was extremely helpful and was able to remind/teach me of things I may have forgotten or not have studied otherwise. It doesn't try to teach everything all over again but goes into details on certain areas and topics that are frequently tested. It is easy to read and use. I passed my test and I am certain the book helped out.

although this seems like a good study tool, I have only had it for an hour and found some problems. the initial test has some blatant errors- not misspellings, but misinformation. the book also goes into detail about ET tubes, I don't know if this use to be an EMT-B procedure but it no longer is. so, I would say it is a good tool, but read it with a wary eye and don't let it be your only research. if you have a question about something you read in the book, or something sounds fishy, look it up! remember that this book was not necessarily written by trained EMS professionals.

I teach EMTs and I was looking for a study guide to help them through the National Registry. I purchased several different books to find one I preferred. This was great for an individual to review but there was another book with harder sample exams that I preferred.

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
