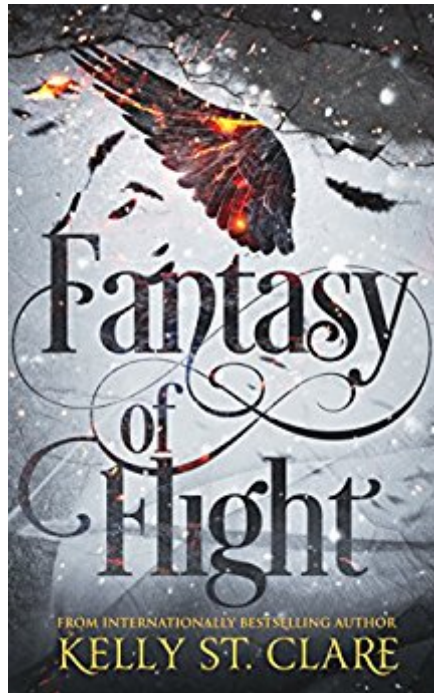




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Fantasy Of Flight (The Tainted Accords Book 2)

Lol This is not a bad reaction, no it's one of fondness and intrigue. I really enjoyed this book. I like the addition of so many new characters and the interactions between them and Lina. However, there were many, many, many times I wanted to reach into the pages of this book and snatch that gal up and choke the craziness out of her. Seriously she made me so mad a few times I just had to walk away. But I came back cause dang it, I had to know what that crazy gal was up to next. The pages flowed slow at times, and a little too quickly on parts but I think the overall balance is there. Lina is danger magnet. Like seriously. She becomes one of the best fighters on the pits of the outer rings, all while searching for Kedrick's killer. One thing turns to two and then it all comes crashing down. As with anything Lina does she pulls out all the stops. Thank God Jovan has seen her without her veil. It's seriously the ONLY thing that saves her hide and the hides of the men she's grown to call family. This in turn gives her a reunion with the castle but not as herself. Things get tricky and in the blink of an eye, she's running. Once again she's on the outskirts but when word gets to her a Solati man has been taken to the king she has to go see who it is. When Lina sets eyes on her brother, she's herself again. Back in the place she just ran from. Back where she ran from the man, the king that wants and needs her... It makes it hard when word gets to her that trouble is heading their way. Death may be calling on them all soon. It's up to Lina to find a way around it... She has one shot at this... if she fails, many will die.

This second novel is more complex, more exciting but maintains the easy reading style. I don't want to tell you the story in this review. In book 1 we are introduced to two unique worlds, Osolis and Glacium. This new and original author adds an exciting and unique twist here but you will need to read the book but I was not expecting this. The Characters Olina's life is still intriguing as she faces life threatening situations in her new employment. She also has to contend with complex relationships and friendships and her own sexuality. The mystery of the veil is never

far away. There are more characters in book 2, however, I didn't find this hard to follow and I didn't struggle to figure out or keep track of who was who. The personalities, verbal interaction, humour, camaraderie were so well developed they felt real. I found the emotional content, humour, distress, trauma, relationship building was well done and believable. All credit to the author who has the ability to bring to life such distinct personalities and work them into the novel. Current Topic Though this is a sci fi fantasy book it could also be advertised in other genres. Abuse still weaves an evil vein throughout the second book and it is interesting to see how Olina's childhood role models have provided her with some base skills to strive and survive. The second book does a wonderful job of balancing Olina's conflict. To clarify this is not a dark and depressive book in fact I find it just the opposite. The main characters have the qualities of integrity, honour and kindness but also highlights challenges and emotional trauma. Overall the book provides HOPE. Romance As expected the romance with Jovan builds and I think the author does a great job of slowly building the sexual tension and friendship. Mystery and Intrigue There were some twists and turns in this novel that I was not anticipating but this was fresh and new and all the more interesting and exciting. The ending is not as abrupt as the first novel but leaves the reader wishing the next book was available because you just know something exciting is just round the corner.

Usually, the 2nd book in a series tends to be without action and occasionally boring as the lead in to the next book. Not this one!! The story is just as action packed as Fantasy of Frost. Quite honestly, I actually liked book 2 better. I love King Jovan. Hehehe, can you say book boy crush. ;-) I truly enjoyed getting to know the delegates more.
