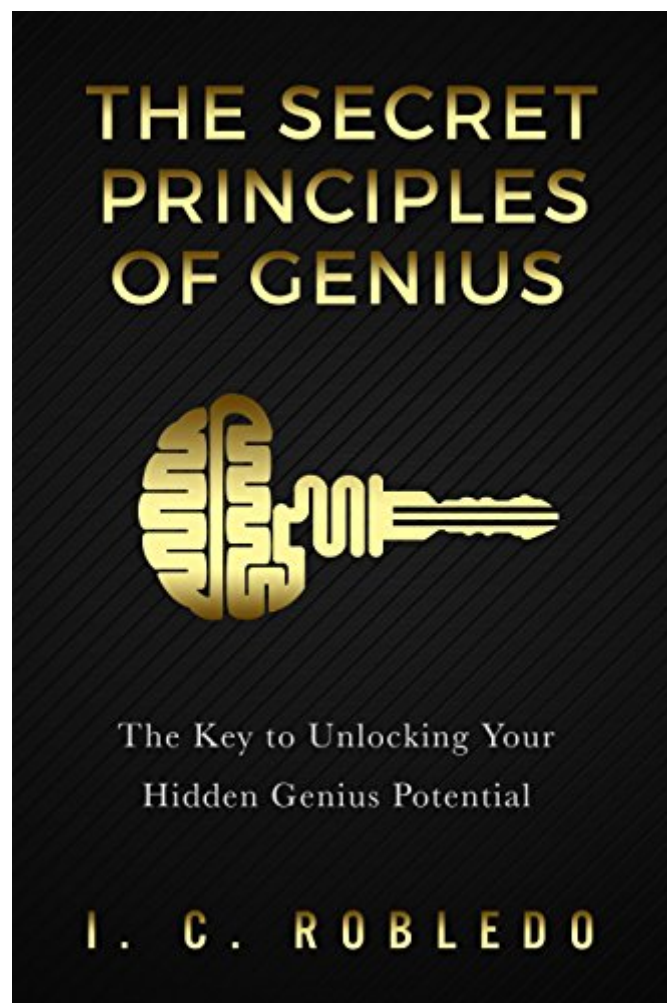


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The Secret Principles Of Genius: The Key To Unlocking Your Hidden Genius Potential
