

Yes, those wacky zombies are at it again. If you go into the "Plants vs. Zombies" comics expecting something dark and gritty, or even coherent, you're going to be disappointed. But if you don't mind a zany plot, goofball humor, and artwork stuffed with visual gags, you'll most likely enjoy this series. And "Petal to the Metal" is a fun ride for all ages. Dr. Zomboss is at it again -- this time trying to create vehicles that will enable his zombie hordes to take over Neighborville with ease. Thankfully, Crazy Dave is up to the challenge (once he's done trying to beat the high score on his favorite video game, "Don't Blink"), and he's created a sun-powered roadster of his own. Soon it becomes a race, with Nick, Patricia, and Dave's plants pitted against Zomboss' outlandish but dangerous vehicles... and the stakes have never been higher, for whoever loses the race will have to leave Neighborville forever! With weird obstacles, Zomboss' smog machine, and Nick's pizza craving slowing them down, can the two kids and their plant buddies defeat Zomboss once and for all? Yes, it's pretty goofy and silly. And sadly, the plants of the title take a backseat in this issue, which focuses more on the human kids and the race than on plants fighting zombies. But kids will still enjoy it, and adults will get a kick out of some of the visual gags and the grotesque, slapstick antics of the zombies. This comic series knows what it is -- a silly and light-hearted outing only loosely based on the game it borrows its name from -- and it has fun with that premise. And the artwork remains fun, detailed without being disgusting and nicely stylized, and mostly stays true to the visual look of the games. This comic includes some bonus stories as well, including a film-noir-esque story with Nick as the detective. Most of these stories appear to be done by different artists, but it's nice seeing a little artistic variety in this series. Probably best for kids who are fans of the game, this is still a

lighthearted series, and a fun bit of escapism for fans of the game or just for anyone wanting a lighter zombie read after "The Walking Dead."

My son is a PVZ nut... he likes these books so when I tell him to get off the XBox, he has something to do. Heaven forbid our children go outside.... *insert eye roll*

OK, let's be honest. Plants versus zombies does not float my boat. But my seven-year-old grandson was over the moon about it. I must say I am glad to see The graphics were quite good and the game itself is not focused on killing other people. More imagination and fantasy centered than realistic.
