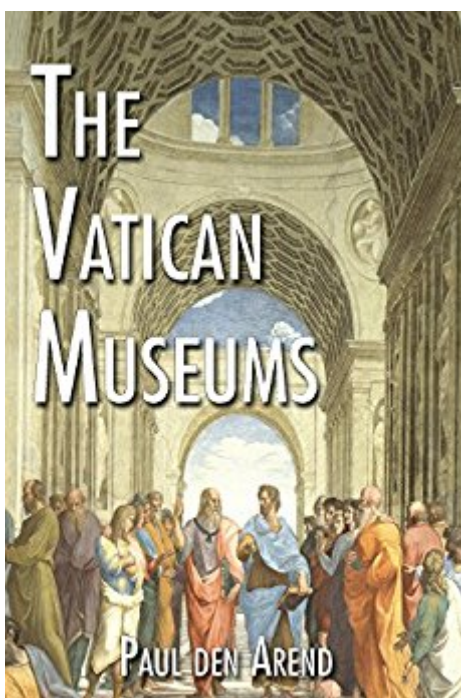




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The Vatican Museums: Including Michelangelo's Sistine Chapel And The Raphael Rooms
