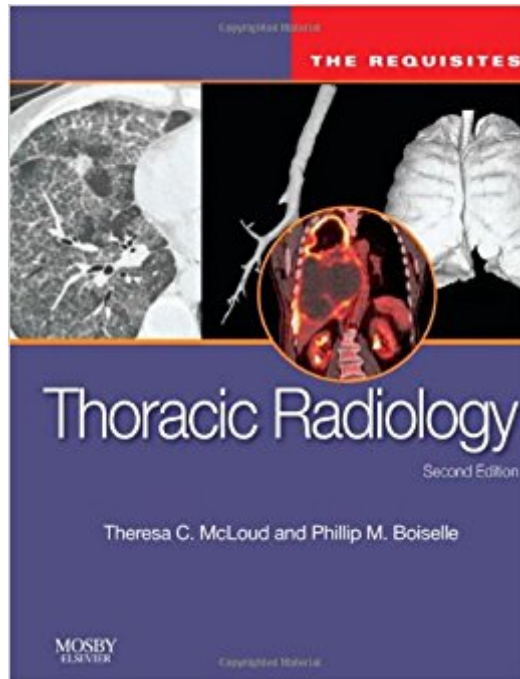

As the title says, this is a good compromise if you don't want to splash out and spend the money on the newer edition. There's not that much difference between the two in actual content, but obviously this edition is a little dated. There are a few changes in terminology, but at the end of the day the images are still as relevant as when it was first published. Very straight-talking text with excellent examples of xrays shown...plenty of High res CT too! A bargain now as the new edition is out, but a good alternative if you don't mind it being a bit dated.
