

Written in prose instead of rhyme (unlike Seuss's later works), *The King's Stilts* nevertheless addresses subjects that we know Dr. Seuss was passionate about throughout his life: duty (as in *Horton Hears a Who* and *Horton Hatches the Egg*); the abuse of power (as in *The 500 Hats of Bartholomew Cubbins* and *Yertle the Turtle*); deceit (as in *The Bippolo Seed* and *How the Grinch Stole Christmas*)—and even cats (as in *The Cat in the Hat* and *I Can Lick 30 Tigers Today!*)! A perfect way to introduce new readers to an old classic, or to reward existing fans with a collectible new edition. Follow the Good Doctor's advice: After a hard day of work, have fun with a great book like *The King's Stilts*!
