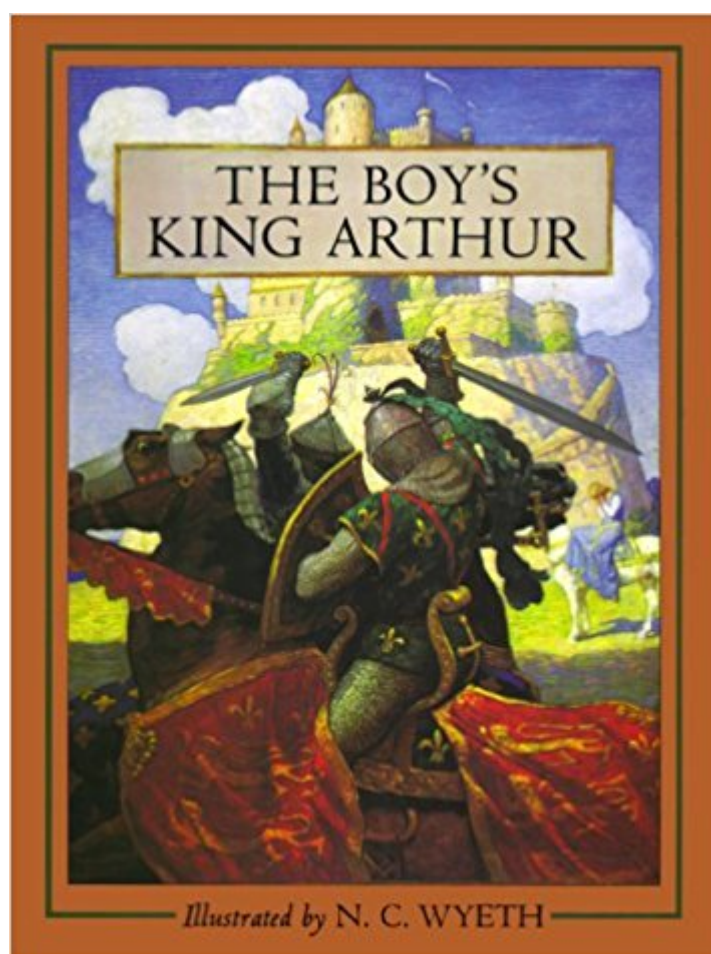

Sidney Lanier (1842-1881) was born in Macon, Georgia. After serving in the Confederate Army during the Civil War, he held a variety of jobs and traveled widely throughout the northern and southern states. In addition to earning success as a poet, Lanier received praise as a professional flutist with the Peabody Symphony Orchestra in Baltimore before he died of tuberculosis in 1881. [Newell] C[onvers] Wyeth is one of the most famous and beloved American illustrators of the twentieth century. A student of Howard Pyle's Brandywine School of American Illustration, Wyeth became known around the world for his work. His powerful, romantic illustrations for such classics as *Treasure Island*, *Robin Hood*, and *Robinson Crusoe* have shaped the imaginations of four generations. --This text refers to an out of print or unavailable edition of this title.

Such beautiful language! I pre-read this book for my sons. There was nothing I wouldn't want them to read but I was surprised to find such lovely language in what is otherwise a fairly typical retelling of Arthurian legend.

This is basically a literal rendition of Malloy's "Morte de Aurthur (sp)". The language is real old English and essentially word for word. The author has interpolated helpful renditions of the old words and phrases where appropriate..Very delightful if you are really into the legends. In spite of the title, this is definitely not for boys.

I first read this book when I was seven years old and loved, I am sixty two now. I have searched for this book for years. The copy I got from was gifted to some in 1932 and signed. I am very pleased.

A superbly lovely book with illustrations by N.C. Wyeth. Doesn't get any better for the enchantment of children. And the company was exceptionally easy to work with. Highly recommended!

This was part of my library 70 years ago. It's an old-fashioned classic that may not appeal to today's youth, but I purchased it for my grandson on a sentimental impulse. The illustrations alone are worth the price.

The Kindle edition has no illustrations that I can find. What a waste! Too bad doesn't caution you about this before you buy!

This book is an obvious and poor photocopy (you can see faint library marks on some pages). The illustrations are barely distinguishable and the type is faded. There is even a dark shadow on the top of each page where the paper was not against the copier. I am shocked would sell such a poor product. It is going right back. Don't be fooled!
