

This Guide offers the reader a larger, more comprehensive version of the booklet (LWB) that accompanied the 2013 publication of the iconic Revised New Art Tarot, originally published in 1929. This historic deck marked a period of significant collaboration between J. Augustus Knapp and Manly P. Hall, including Knapp's illustrations for Hall's 1928 encyclopedic masterpiece, *The Secret Teachings of all Ages*. Relying mostly on Manly P. Hall's work, the author presents the Knapp-Hall Tarot following the teachings of the main esoteric traditions at the time of the original publication, while emphasizing the deep mystical content of this extraordinary, magical work. This new edition of the Knapp-Hall deck closely follows Knapp's original color scheme and style. The book offers suggestions for divination and meditation with the cards through the mysterious heraldic symbols added by Manly P. Hall and the dynamics of color, geometric patterns and numbers, while concentrating on the transformative dimensions of the Tree of Life, which serves as our roadmap to penetrate the ancient mysteries. The deck and this book represent a compendium of knowledge that has guided our civilization since the beginning of Time.

Superb book for beginners and advanced.

I don't use the deck that this book accompanies but it was still very insightful & provided new knowledge.

A thoughtful revision, however, some purists may not find this as rewarding as intended. It is stated in the little booklet that the original name of the deck was "The Revised New Art Tarot" back in 1929 when they were creating the deck, however, it became the Knapp Deck or Knapp-Hall deck. For years it has been in and out of print and until recently become quite expensive. Thankfully PRS has decided to reprint this once again. The major difference you will note is the size of the cards. They are closer to a standard size of tarot cards these days, however, slightly wider (for proportion purposes). The other more subtle differences is that the cards are coated for longevity and they did their best to keep the character and charm of the original without tweaking too much of the color but kept strict attention to the symbolism of the color. Some slight misregistration they have kept to keep consistent from past decks. The deck comes with 2 Fool cards. The second being the Knapp poster or large Tarot painting as shown in the Secret Teachings of All Ages. For those that do not know, John Augustus Knapp who illustrated this deck with the aid from Manly Hall, also illustrated Secret Teachings of All Ages, where his work has become iconic in the occult field. The art print looks, for the most part, clean, but I feel like blowing it up, even a little, seemed to lose some of the original. I don't have the original deck anymore so I don't have it for immediate comparison. It comes in a nice blue box with a 56 page booklet explaining the changes in this deck and of course the attributes to the cards. The text explaining the symbolism is from Manly Hall in his writings in the periodical All Seeing Eye, 1931. If you are unfamiliar with this deck and collect Tarot decks, you will not want to miss out, especially if Kabbalah symbolism speaks to you. Which I might add is another change they made: the back of the card. As noted in the introduction of the booklet, because readers use right side up and upside down readings, they decided to go with a design that was symmetrical (pics included) Overall I am pleased with my purchase. I would like to add that the price here has for the deck seems steep. I am not sure why it costs that much and if you know how to search in the right places, you can find it at a more reasonable cost of \$35.
