This light novel just arrived. The novel continues the adventures of Sadao Maou and Emi Yuusa in their [more like her] battle against each other and others. The novel series is Slice of Life with comedy, a hint of romantic tension, and a few "over the top" action scenes. This continues more of what was in the 1st novel and the events of this book are present within the anime so if you can't wait, just go watch that, or if you have watched that then you know what to expect! shipped the book well this time, but they continue to have problems shipping standalone paperbacks so I would

be careful [they do offer returns/refunds with no hassle, but it does become one when you have to return several items in a row because of poor packaging; gas isn't cheap!; in that sense you do lose some money]. The writing, much like most light novels, isn't the best in the world, but I read this series for it's characters which have intrigued me. The world building continues to be good with new characters and factions appearing. Not to mention the "Other-World" which we don't even know much about and will be featured heavily in future novels.

This second volume still treads on ground covered by the anime however it provides a few really minor extra moments and character interaction moments that make it a must read. Probably, I would say the internal thoughts of both Maa, Chiyo, Emi, Suzuno, and such regarding their relationships makes it seem to go beyond what the anime covered. For one who may not have seen the anime this wouldn't matter as because of their thoughts and mannerisms in the novel I think we get to see how everyone is actually pretty human and real. No one is too evil or too good, and it also raises a good question about the character of the "Devil King". Hopefully the next volumes go more into the question this volume finally brought up. Chiyo is an excellent third party to help enhance and develop the cast. Good action, great character interactions even if Ashiya and Urushihara had kind of minor roles (though they still had a few pages worth of dialogue during key arcs), and good comedy. Pick it up.

Another great Light Novel volume. As the content covered by the Anime finally reaches my shelves I have to say it was an enjoyable read. The plot remains more or less the same but we have more background to some of the characters and some things that were left out of the anime are properly explained here. I'm really looking forward to the third volume which will finally reach events that weren't covered in the anime.
