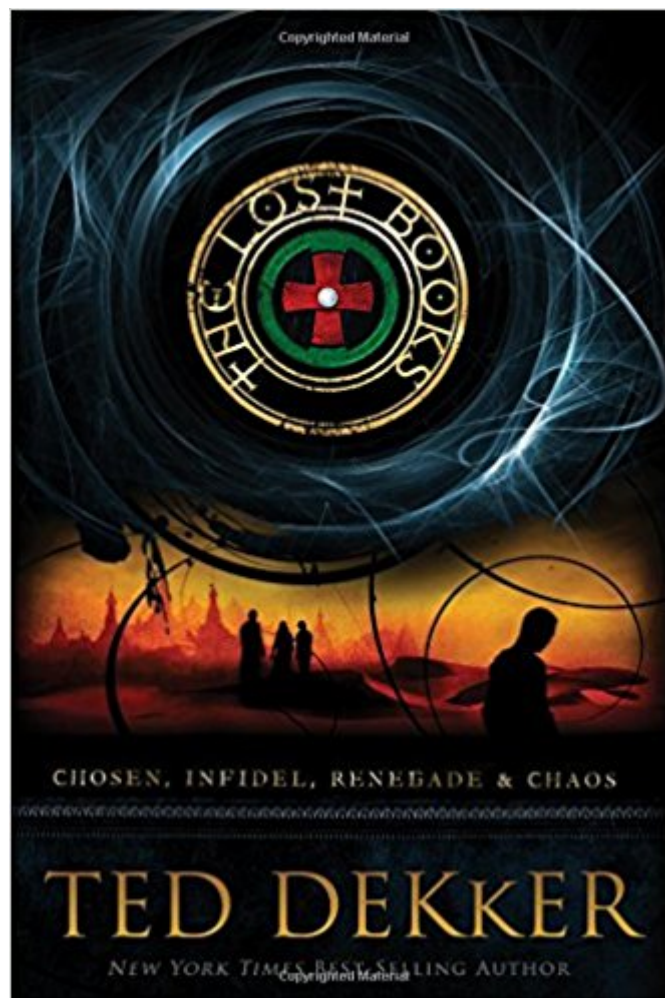

This series of books was quick reading; in fact I found them very hard to stop reading and go to bed!!! Although these books are indicated for YA, I would recommend them for all ages. There was quite a lot of action, time travel and humor. There were some "romantic" parts, but this was written

by a Christian author, so those excerpts were cleanly written and appropriate for all ages. The characters, Johnis, Silvie, Darsal and Billos, were all endearing, lovable, frustrating and sometimes I wanted to smack one or all of them upside their heads!!!!
