

This book will fulfill a long felt need for information and profound practical hints, for the management of the common serious conditions (largely traumatic) that afflict the Emergency Rooms of 3/4 of the world's hospitals. This book should be much more useful in the context of where it is directed to, than all the advanced Journals of Modern Orthopaedics. Previously the most valuable books were those of 70 years ago, such as Charnley's *Closed Treatment of Common Fractures* or Crawford Adams' *Outline of Fractures*. But this book has been expected to be right up to date with the scene which is relevant today, without being based on manufactured implants or unobtainable scanners.
