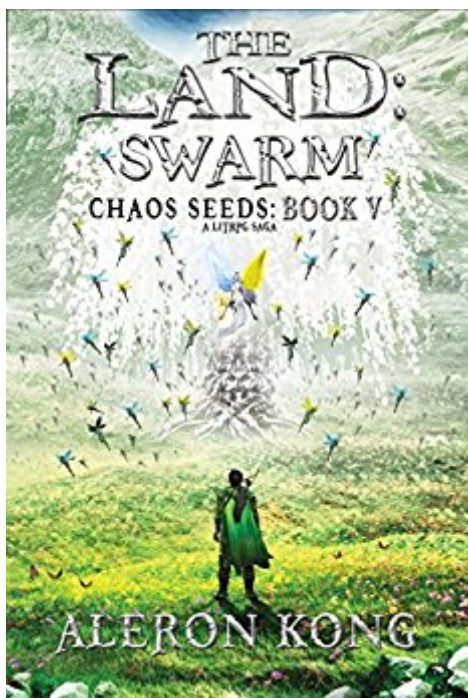


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# The Land: Swarm: A LitRPG Saga (Chaos Seeds Book 5)

If you like the first four books, you like this one as well. Richter's personality still irks me, but the game elements and the story keeps me engaged. Now if only Aleron Kong would resolve some of the major storylines of the previous parts instead of adding a new one on the pile...

Obviously, you should not start reading the story at the fifth book in the series. So if you haven't read the first four, which are phenomenal, go back and do that right now. For those of you still with

me, you're in for a great ride. As some reviewers have noted, this one is a bit different as it focuses on his development of his village/town. That is part of what makes it so great for me. Over the last several books, you really feel the urgency under which the MC is operating. There are so many things to do as he quickly attempts to develop and get stronger while at the same time trying to give his town and people the attention they deserve. I like the skill grinding of the LitRPG genre as much as the next guy, but I really enjoy it when an author takes a slightly different approach. I'd say this series is one of the top 5 in the genre. Two thumbs up. Just read it already.

Another good book, though this one felt like more of a filler I guess. It goes pretty in depth about the future of the village and the technology system of building a village. This is also the second book that the title made no sense, the swarm (which I assume is the eaters that everyone is afraid about) is talked about for like 2 pages at the end of the book but are never seen. Also the main character is apparently bi-sexual though it's kinda just mentioned in passing so if that bothers you I guess skip that page.

Aleron Kong has established himself as a top notch writer, not just the niche' LitRPG writer. His books are eventful and compelling. I have read every book in "The Land" series and they each move well into the next. Of course I ran into the issue where I have caught up to Mr. Kong, and now am awaiting his next book... which I am really looking forward to. Overall these books are among the best in the "gaming" genre and are polished and well written. Enjoy these, they are well worth it!
