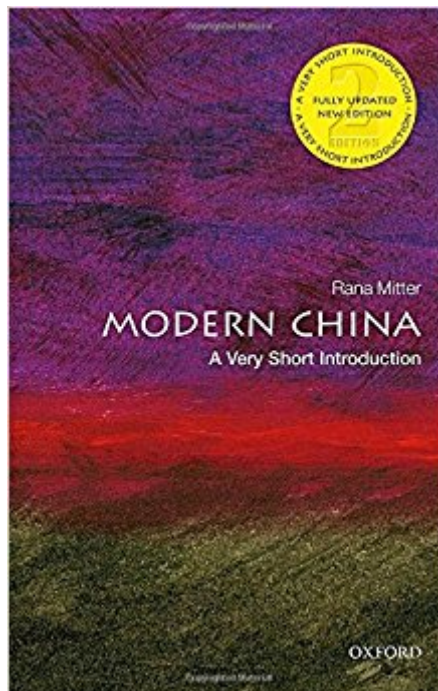




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Modern China: A Very Short Introduction (Very Short Introductions)

2004). His most recent book is *China's War with Japan, 1937-1945* (Penguin, 2014), which won the 2014 Duke of Westminster's Medal for Military Literature, and was a 2014 CHOICE Outstanding Academic Title. He is a presenter for BBC Radio 3's arts and ideas programme, *Free Thinking*.
